The National Infantry Foundation, a not-for-profit 501(c)(3) charitable corporation, has announced plans to build a new "world class" National Infantry Museum to replace the existing facility. The effort is a partnership between the National Infantry Association/Foundation, the Center of Military History, Fort Benning and the City of Columbus, Georgia. A 200 acre site just inside the main gate of Fort Benning on Benning Boulevard has been designated as the future location for the new museum. The Foundation has employed the services of the world renowned museum consulting firm, Lord Cultural Resources of Toronto and Washington DC to prepare a Master Plan for the project.

The current collection of Infantry artifacts on display is most impressive and includes many one-of-a-kind items that would be the envy of most military museums. However, in order to do justice to the collection and to be able to more effectively tell the story of the history of the Infantry, the museum must have a new home. The reason for undertaking the project is best described in the Foundation's Vision Statement:

- To tell the story of the US Army Infantry (past, present and future)
- To pay tribute to those who have served our nation, especially those who have made the ultimate sacrifice
- To educate current and future generations on the military's role in our society, the price paid for our freedom and the guiding principles that made it possible
