

PLDC CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST

Part I of the Pre-Execution Checklist must reflect that the soldier has all appropriate clothing and equipment. All students must bring all seasonal clothing and equipment that is on the attached checklist.

The Henry Caro NCO academy will not issue missing TA-50 items except for the following circumstances:

- (a) Coordination is made with the Commandant BEFORE the student arrives at PLDC.
- (b) The soldier presents a memorandum listing the missing items and the reason why the unit could not obtain the items.
- (c) The above memorandum is signed by the first LTC in the soldier's Chain of Command.
- (d) The soldier is on Recruiter Duty.

It is the responsibility of the unit to correct all shortages prior to the student arriving for in processing. It is also the responsibility of the unit to correct all shortages within the first week of PLDC.

Soldiers still missing items after 72 hours will not be allowed to compete for honors.

(*) Indicates winter only (winter months November to April)

1. In accordance with AR 670-1, Jungle boots are not a substitute for black leather boots. Black leather boots must be IAW AR 670-1.
2. Bring frame, all straps and belts required for use with the rucksack (ALICE pack).
3. To prevent embarrassing situations after duty hours, soldiers are required to be appropriately attired (not just undergarments) when walking out of barracks room. At a minimum the summer IPFU.
4. Items marked with an * are winter items.
5. Civilian clothes are authorized to bring (two sets). They will be authorized to wear during passes and team building functions. Clothes will be of good taste, slacks, dress jeans, pullover or button shirt, blouse, skirt and dress shoes. NO t-shirts, jeans with holes, sweats, or anything that can be considered offensive.

NOTES:

- Gray or Black spandex biker shorts are authorized with the IPFU.
- If the sleeping bag is Gortex intermediate or extreme cold, it is a 4 part system must have it all.
- Toilet articles must be of standard size (sample sizes will not be accepted).
- All students are required to sleep in minimum of Physical Fitness Uniform (summer).
- There is absolutely no requirement to buy a new issue of clothing to attend the PLDC. The clothing and equipment must be clean, serviceable, and properly fitted in accordance with AR 700-84, and TM 10-227. The chain of command must inspect the Class A uniform prior to attending the PLDC for proper fit, serviceability, positioning of shoulder sleeve insignia, service stripes and insignia of grade. All authorized awards and decorations must be verified and worn in accordance with AR 670-1.

 - **Alarm clock**
 - **Small iron and hangers**
 - **Extra PT uniforms**
 - **Extra socks and underclothes**
 - **Extra pin on rank**
 - **Extra ID tags**
 - **Large rucksack w/frame**
 - **Mechanical pencil .05 & No.2 pencil**
 - **Laundry detergent (Liquid)**
 - **Phone card / change**
 - **Calculator / ruler / 2x5 & 5x7 cards**
 - **Money for hygienic items / hair cut**
